Requirements



- Must be a female between the ages of 5 and 12 years old.
- Must use a wheelchair for 100% of daily mobility outside the home.
- Must have resided in the state of Kansas for 6 months prior to the annual event.
- Must be willing to travel to various cities in KS and fulfill the Little Miss mission.

Becoming a Contestant

- Contestants are nominated and must agree to the nomination. Nominator fills out nomination form.
- Form submitted with a short video made by contestant and portrait.
- Applications reviewed by a selection committee and winner is announced at annual crowning.
- All contestants invited to part of the Ms. Wheelchair Kansas weekend.
